

California Compliance Declaration

Puma Biotechnology, Inc. is committed to maintaining high standards of ethical, moral, and legal business conduct and complying with all applicable laws and regulations. Puma has established a comprehensive Compliance Program that incorporates the seven elements of an effective program as recommended in the Compliance Program Guidance for Pharmaceutical Manufacturers published by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Office of Inspector General (OIG), and which includes policies consistent with the Pharmaceutical Research and Manufacturers of America (PhRMA) Code on Interactions with Health Care Professionals (PhRMA Code).

Puma's Compliance Program is reviewed by a Compliance Committee with the responsibility for establishing a culture of compliance, monitoring compliance with company policies, and taking corrective and/or disciplinary action when necessary. The Compliance Program includes policies and procedures, which are periodically reviewed to ensure consistency with current laws and guidance. The program is designed to prevent, detect, and remediate violations of law, regulations, and company policies. The program also guides our interactions with healthcare professionals and healthcare entities.

Puma has established an independent hotline for employees and others to communicate compliance concerns anonymously. Any potential or actual violations of policy or law are investigated and, if necessary, followed by appropriate remedial or corrective actions in accordance with Puma's Compliance Program. For purposes of complying with the California Health and Safety Code 119402, Puma has established a maximum annual aggregate dollar limit of \$2,000 for meals, promotional materials, or educational materials provided to California health care professionals.
